Hospice MDP is the only comprehensive management training program available that provides hospice-specific information and helps managers develop the skills they need to meet the challenges and changes they face in managing programs, systems and people.

The initial component of the Hospice MDP is a two-day foundational course that provides 5 foundational modules of the Hospice MDP. Following the two-day course, if participants desire to obtain Level 1 Designation they will complete 2 additional modules online, at their own pace. Participants may then begin Level II modules, choosing from a menu of options designed to meet their specific needs and enhance their effectiveness.

The Hospice MDP Foundational Course is the first step in a multi-level developmental program for new and aspiring hospice managers. Starting with the enduring and important values that undergird the provision of hospice and palliative care, the course provides information about hospice regulations and standards, includes a leadership assessment and model to help managers determine employee's needs, helps develop critical thinking skills in the hospice manager and teaches strategies to employ during interviewing, coaching, feedback and evaluation processes.
